

Deirdre, I must be on your wanted list! I will answer your questions and will list them below:

- 1. No Health certificate is required for slaughter horses when going direct to slaughter (in the United States). A Health certificate is required when moving horses to Canada for feeding purposes along with a current negative EIA Test listed on the certificate. No, a Health Certificate (VS 17-140) is required for ALL ANIMALS EXPORTED
- 2. Most generally there is no statement/interview log from the slaughter facility. You are right, the only document that is sent from Canadian Slaughter Plants is the "Record of Movement of Horses for Slaughter from the USA" and sometimes this document is not included either. Please explain where you got exhibit 9 (6 pages). You have "received this document from "endorsed on the back of this exhibit. It had to come from somewhere (((the slaughter facility!!!))) This form lists the VS 17-140 numbers, can you get these export papers. If I read this case correctly, how do we know it ever left the US other than the Canadian Slaughter facility receiving the animals??? Right. This form also lists the seals placed, that would show it leaving the US/entering Canada, right?
- 3. The Port Veterinarians conduct these inspections. Both USDA (USDA makes sure there are export papers only) and Canadian Veterinarians (do the Canadian side inspection) inspect the livestock upon arrival at the port before it is allowed to move any further into Canada. Horses are not unloaded at the port, so the port authorities use very tall ladders that move the full length of the transport vehicle to visually inspect the animals through the slats in the trailer sides. They check to make sure there is not any animals down in the trailer or animals that are not compatible with one another. If the trailer needs to be unloaded they are turned around (by who the Canadians) and would have to return to the nearest facility that could accommodate this procedure. As far as I know their facilities up there are not equipped for this.
- 4. In some cases we might interview the drivers, but in this case Musick L/S is the transporter and

stated that he is responsible for the drivers and all his drivers were on the west coast at the time of the investigation, transporting feeder cattle.

Clear copies of all documents should accompany the case to the investigator.

SYNOPSIS

On 01/11/09 and 02/23/09 Musick Livestock, LLC (ML) did not complete VS Forms 10-13 (Owner/Shipper Certificate, Fitness to Travel to a Slaughter Facility) for equine exported to Canada. The Owner/Shipper Certificates , dated 01/11/09 & 02/23/09 were presented at a slaughter facility in Canada and did not meet the standards in 9 C.F.R. § 88. United States Department of Agriculture (USDA), Animal Plant Health Inspection Service (APHIS), Veterinary Services (VS) then requested an investigation into ML and was initiated by Investigative and Enforcement Services (IES) Investigator (b)(6) & (b)(7)c

BACKGROUND

Subject(s) Information

ML is a family owned livestock business and been in business for the past forty years. Tanner Musick is currently the owner of ML and is located at 3201 N. Ohlman Street Mitchell, SD 57301. ML is licensed in the State of South Dakota as a Livestock Dealer (# 8025). ML is incorporated in the State of South Dakota with a corporation number of DL003510 (Exhibits 1 & 2).

NARRATIVE

Basis for Investigation

Joey Astling, Compliance Specialist, USDA, APHIS, VS, requested this investigation in a letter dated April 17, 2009 (stamped date) (Exhibit 3).

Investigative Findings

On 01/11/09, ML shipped two loads of slaughter horses to Natural Meats in Canada. One load consisting of 33 head of horses and the other load consisting of 37 head of horses. ML is required to complete a VS Form 10-13 for each group going direct to slaughter. The VS Form 10-13's were not fully completed by ML leaving the section "Time Horses Loaded on Conveyance" blank for each load. Required also is that all horses being shipped directly to slaughter must be officially identified. The VS Form 10-13's for both loads were completed in full by ML with official identification listed, but upon arrival at Natural Meats in Canada, Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA) noted on the VS Form 10-13 for 33 head, noted on page 2, *Missing 50% back tags*. The VS Form 10-13 for 37 head, noted on page 2, * No back tags visible on any colts* (Exhibits 4 & 5).

On 02/23/09, ML shipped one load of slaughter horses to Norval Meats (formerly Natural Meats) consisting of 39 head and completed VS Form 10-13 as required for this movement (Exhibit 4).

On 02/24/09, CFIA completed a Canadian Form "Record of Movement of Horses for Slaughter from the USA". This form was completed at 2:00 P.M., the time of arrival of the ML load of slaughter horses to the slaughter facilities in Canada. This form indicated under the "Questions Section # 4" that numerous horses were missing back tags and were noted on the VS Form 10-13, dated 02/23/09, as a non- check mark beside the numbers on the left side of the document on pages 1 & 2 with a total of 26 horses missing tags upon arrival. It is also required by ML if offloading is required en route to the slaughtering facility, the owner/shipper must prepare another owner/shipper certificate. It was noted on the "Record of Movement of Horses for Slaughter from the USA" that a rest stop was made at Atkins, IL and a second set of a VS 10-13 was not completed to move the load of horses to the final destination in Canada as required. The form also made note of copies of the driver's log would be attached as collected documents. The month of February, 2009 spread sheet from the slaughtering facility was included indicating all arrivals to the plant with slaughter horses (Exhibits 6, 7, 8 & 9).

On 01/29/10, Tanner Musick of ML was interviewed at 3201 N. Ohlman Street Mitchell, SD 57301. IES presented all documents to ML and discussed all areas of concern regarding the alleged non compliance issues. An affidavit was presented to ML for review and after review ML would decide whether or not to sign this form. ML chose to prepare his own statement and provide any documentation along with his statement pertaining to the alleged violation. On 02/03/10 Investigator, received ML's statement. ML states in this statement that all of the horses were back tagged and that he was present when they were tagged. The horses that had been transported were young horses and were tagged prior to loading, so they could have been rubbed off as to why the horses were missing tags at arrival at the slaughter plant. ML also stated that he has not sent any horses to Canada for approximately one year (Exhibit 10).

On March 11, 2010 a follow-up interview was conducted with ML verifying the identification that was stated in ML's statement dated 01/31/2010. Mr. Musick clarified what was meant in his statement that he was present at the time of the Official Identification was applied to each horse meant that he applied the official tags himself. He stated that he is always present when loading of the horses to document the identification markings to list them on the VS Form 10-13 prior to shipment and place the official tags on each horse (Exhibit 11).

These findings substantiate the following alleged violation(s):

9 C.F.R. § 88.4 (a) (3) (ix) Requirements for transport.

The regulation states that the date, time and the place the equine was loaded on the conveyance must be documented on the VS Form 10-13. This information was excluded from the forms, dated 01/11/09.

9 C.F.R. § 88.4 (b) (4) Requirements for transport.

The regulation states that if unloading is required en route to the slaughtering facility, the owner/shipper must prepare another own/shipper certificate and record the date, time and location where the offloading occurred. If this occurs both owner/shipper certificates must accompany the equine to the slaughtering facility. On 02/23/09, 39 head of horses on the ML transport vehicle stopped for offloading and did not prepare second VS 10-13 as required.

These findings indicate that the evidence does not support a violation of the following section(s):

9 C.F.R. § 88.4 (a) (2) Requirements for transport.

The regulation states that the owner/shipper must apply a USDA back tag to each equine in the shipment. Although CFIA did mark and initial the 10-13's that the horses in question did not arrive at unloading with a USDA back tag, photographs of the inside of the transport vehicle showing any evidence of tags and the horses in the pens showing evidence that the horses were not officially identified were not taken for verification. All equine are uniquely identified by color, sex and breed and could be identified by those characteristics to match the VS Form 10-13 as these characteristics are listed on the VS Form 10-13. Therefore the official identification cannot be verified if certain equine were identified or not.






Our family has been in the livestock business for the past forty years and I am presently the owner of Musick Livestock, LLC located at 3201 N Ohlman Street, Mitchell, SD 57301. I am licensed in the State of South Dakota as a Livestock Dealer (#8025) as well as North Dakota and Montana. I am incorporated in the State of South Dakota with a number of DL003510.

I met with Mr. who identified himself as an investigator with the United States Department of Agriculture, Animal Plant Health Inspection Service, Investigative and Enforcement Services about the two movements of 33 & 37 head of horses that were listed on VS Form 10-13's dated 01/11/09, and a movement for 39 head of horses that were listed on a VS Form 10-13 dated 2/23/09.

In both incidents I was present when the above mentioned horses were back tagged. Every horse was tagged at Musick Livestock, LLC prior to loading and transporting to Norval Meats in Ontario, Canada. Approximately, a year and half ago I spoke with border inspector, in Port Huron, Michigan. He informed me that in case back tags where lost or chewed off by other horses while transporting a written description of the horse along with the tag number would be sufficient. Since that time we have included a written description of every horse and the tag number on the VS Form 10-13 that leaves our premises. The above mentioned horses would have also had the description of each on the VS Form 10-13.

These two loads in question were younger horses that came off a feed lot and sat in a holding pen for two days while waiting for transportation paperwork. During this waiting period young horses have tendency to play, rub against feeders, bite each other, etc and this could be the explanation as to why a tag was missing or found on another horses nose.

As you can see we have tried to make every effort to abide by all regulations and have not had any incidents in over four years. To date we have not sent any horses into Canada for approximately a year.

SUMMARY:

On March 10, 2010 I contacted Musick Livestock Co., LLC located at 3201 North Ohlman Mitchell, South Dakota 57301 and left a message for a return call. On March 11, 2010 I received a return call from Tanner Musick and he agreed to discuss the tagging issue as stated in his statement.

Mr. Musick stated in his statement that he was present during the tagging of the horses that were shipped on 01/11/2009. Mr. Musick was asked if he meant that someone other than himself tagged the horses for this shipment and he was only there to witness the tagging. He stated that what he meant in his statement was that he tagged all of the horses for that shipment and tags all the horses himself on most occasions. He stated that he is always present when horses are assembled for shipment so correct identification markings are included on the VS Form 10-13 to send with the driver as required.

Mr. Musick was also asked if a second set of VS Form 10-13's were found in records as they might have been left out of transport packet for the driver. He stated that he did not find the second set of documents that are required if a stop is made during the transporting of slaughter horses where the horses are unloaded for rest, food and water.

I thanked Mr. Musick for his return call to me and appreciated his candor when answering all questions presented to him.
