**Subject:** Dallas Crown, Inc. Spill Summary.

As you are aware, Dallas Crown, Inc. had a spill of blood and/or other foreign materials on Tuesday, **September 30**, 2003 at approximately 5:45 p.m. Apparently, **their personnel were** moving a full trailer **from** its location in an attempt to replace it with an **empty** trailer. Either the hitch did **not lock completely** or **malfunctioned which** caused the trailer to come unhitched and tilt causing the spill.

**The Police and Fire Department** were on the scene to close traffic and assist with the situation. Mike Merritt, WWT Plant Superintendent was on the scene to assist with disinfection of the area. Dallas Crown was issued a citation by Code Enforcement regarding the violation of section 50-63 Removal of stagnant water, rubbish, or other impure or unwholesome matter. This material never entered the sanitary sewer system. Therefore, this does not fall within the City's industrial waste ordinance.

Dallas Crown, Inc. contained the material prior to entering the TxDot drainage system. Therefore, none of the spilled material entered a receiving stream. They also acquired the emergency services of American Spill Control to remove the spilled materials and had Gene Busby to dig out and remove all of the affected earth. It was then replaced with new rock and dirt.

I have attached a memo from Mike Merritt along with a letter and attachments from Dallas Crown, Inc..

**Subject:** Dallas Crown, Inc., Trailer Spill.

On September 30, 2003 at approximately 6:00 p.m. I was contacted by the Kaufman Police Department that a spill had occurred in front of Dallas Crown at 2000 W. Fair.

Upon arriving, I noticed that the Fire and Police Department were already on the scene. They had the service road blocked off from through traffic at both directions. I spoke with Chris Soenen, Manager Dallas Crown. They had already contained the spill by damming the ditch prior to entering the TxDot drainage system. I advised Mr. Soenen that they needed to be cleaned up and disinfected the entire area. I also advised him to submit a report to the City addressing the reason for the spill, future prevention, and steps taken to clean up the affected area. American Spill Control pumped out all of the liquid material. Code enforcement arrived and issued a citation for the spill.

I contacted Mr. Bob Ferry, TCEQ Region 4 Field Investigator the following day October 1, 2003 around 9:00 a.m. Mr. Ferry stated that he had already received a complaint earlier that morning in regard to the spill. I explained to him the events as listed above along with the steps Dallas Crown had been required to take for the cleanup. Mr. Ferry stated that he would also be investigating the Dallas Crown, Inc. violation in regard to the spill. I haven't had any additional contact with Mr. Ferry and am unaware if he has completed his investigation. I will keep you updated as I receive additional information.

ON TUESDAY SEPTEMBER 30, 2003 AT APPROXIMATELY 17:51 HOURS I, OFFICER DOUG BARKER #913, RESPONDED TO A CODE VIOLATION AT CROWN PACKING PLANT AT 2000 WEST FAIR STREET IN THE CIT OF KAUFMAN, KAUFMAN COUNTY TEXAS. UPON ARRIVAL I OBSERVED A TRAILER FROM A SEMI TRACTOR TRAILER, LEAKING FLUIDS WHICH TURNED OUT TO BE BLOOD AND OTHER BODILY FLUIDS AT A RAPID RATE. THE FLUIDS WERE POURING OUT INTO THE ROADWAY AND IN THE DRAINAGE DITCH ON THE SIDE OF THE FRONTAGE ROAD. CODE ENFORCEMENT ARRIVED ON SCENE AND ISSUED A CITATION TO THE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE COMPANY. THE EMPLOYEES FROM THE COMPANY REACTED VERY QUICKLY, AND IMMEDIATELY BEGAN CLEAN UP ON THE SPILL. REPRESENTATIVES FROM THE COMPANY ESTIMATED APPROXIMATELY 5000 TO 6000 GALLONS OF BLOOD WAS PORED OUT OF THE TRAILER. N.F.I.

I TOLD DISPATCH TO CONTACT MIKE MERRITT AND HAVE HIM LOOK AT THE SITUATION. DISPATCH CALLED AGAIN AND STATED THAT OFFICER WIDENER STATED THAT CODE ENFORCEMENT WAS NEEDED AT THE SCENE. I CONFIRMED WITH DISPATCH THAT MIKE MERRITT WAS THERE AND WAS TOLD HE WAS ON THE SCENE. I ARRIVED AT DALLAS CROWN AT 1858 HOURS. I OBSERVED THAT THERE WAS MORE THAN BLOOD IN THE ROADWAY. I OBSERVED THAT DALLAS CROWN HAD PEOPLE WORKING ON THE PROBLEM. I SPOKE WITH MIKE MERRITT HE STATED THAT DALLAS CROWN HAD BEEN ABLE TO CONTAIN THE SPILL AND IT HAD NOT REACHED THE CITY WATER SYSTEM. I MET WITH CHRIS SOENEN REPRESENTATIVE FOR DALLAS CROWN. I EXPLAINED THAT DUE TO THE SPILL AND WHAT WAS ON THE ROADWAY AND GRASS AREA THAT I WOULD ISSUE A CITATION. I ISSUED CITATION # 31244 FOR CITY ORDINANCE VIOLATION SECTION 50-63.

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10/1/2003 ON 10-1-03 I WENT TO THE OFFICE OF THE COURT CLERK TO FIND OUT HOW MUCH THE FINE WOULD BE FOR THE CITATION WRITTEN. THERE WAS NO ONE AVAILABLE TO ANSWER MY QUESTION. I RETRIEVED A BOOK THAT HAD A LIST OF FINE AMOUNTS IN IT. I FOUND THE FINE LIST WAS \$201.00. I THEN ASKED DISPATCH TO CONTACT THE JUDGE SO I COULD SPEAK WITH HIM ON THIS MATTER. I MET WITH JUDGE BURT EXPLAINED WHAT HAD HAPPENED AND THE AMOUNT LISTED IN THE FINE BOOK. THE JUDGE STATED THAT DUE TO THE SITUATION AND THE AMOUNT OF SPILL THE FINE WOULD BE THE MAXIMUM \$2,000.00.

HE STATED HE HAD JUST LOOKED AT THE CITATION I HAD ISSUED HIM AND THERE WAS AN ERROR IN THE AMOUNT OF THE SPILL. CHRIS STATED THAT IT WAS NOT 5,000 TO 6,000 GALLONS, IT SHOULD HAVE STATED POUNDS. HE EXPLAINED THAT THEY WORK WITH POUNDS WHEN MAKING ESITMATES FOR THEIR BUSINESS. HE STATED THAT THE TRAILER ONLY HOLDS A MAXIMUM OF 880 GALLONS, SO THE SPILL COULD NOT HAVE BEEN MORE THAN WHAT WAS ON THE TRAILER. CHRIS STATED HE WAS CONCERNED WITH THE ERROR STATING IT WAS GALLONS WHEN IT SHOULD HAVE BEEN POUNDS. I EXPLAINED THAT I WOULD MAKE NOTE OF THAT, BUT THE CITATION AMOUNT WAS ALREADY SET AND THE AMOUNT WRITTEN ON THE CITATION WOULD NOT AFFECT THE FINE AMOUNT.

(Code 1974, § 13-3)



**Sec. 50-63. Removal of stagnant water, rubbish, or other impure or unwholesome matter.**

(a) It shall be the duty of any person owning, claiming, occupying or having supervision or control of any real property, occupied or unoccupied, within the corporate limits of the city, to keep such property owned by him free from stagnant water, rubbish, trash, filth, carrion or other impure or unwholesome matter of any kind; and to keep the sidewalks in front of this property free and clear of these. It shall also be the duty of this person to fill up, drain or regrade any lots, ground or yards which shall be unwholesome or have stagnant water on the lots; and to cleanse and disinfect any house, building, establishment, lot yard or ground from rubbish, trash, filth, carrion or other impure or unwholesome matter of any kind.

(b) The city shall perform work to alleviate drainage problems in dirt alleys and utility easements where it is not practical for two or more private owners to coordinate a solution. (Code 1974, § 13-4)

**Sec. 50-64. Notice to owner to remove; removal by city upon failure of owner to do so.**

If any person owning, claiming, occupying or having supervision or control of any real property occupied or unoccupied within the corporate limits of the city fails to comply with the provisions of sections 50-61—50-63, it shall be the duty of the city to give ten days' notice in writing to such person violating the terms of this article, or by letter addressed to such person at his post office address, or by publication two times within ten consecutive days in the city's official newspaper. If such person fails or refuses to comply with the provisions of such sections within ten days after date of notification in writing or by letter or date of second publication of notice in the city's official newspaper, the city may go upon such property and do or cause to be done the work necessary to obtain compliance with this article, and may charge the expenses incurred in doing or in having same done to the owners of such property as provided in this article in compliance with V.T.C.A., Health and Safety Code § 342.001 et seq. (Code 1974, § 13-5)

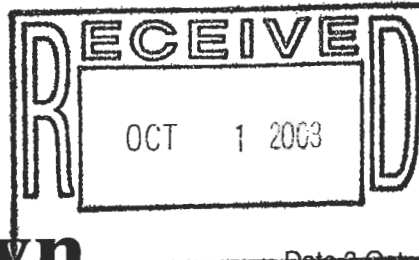
**Sec. 50-65. Charges when work is done by city—Enumerated.**

(a) The expenses incurred by the city pursuant to the correcting of conditions as set forth in this article shall be charged to and become a lien on the real estate or lots upon which such expense is incurred. Such charges to be levied shall include special expense fees to defer all expense incurred by the city and shall be as follows:

- (1) Single residential lot, with/without dwelling, per lot..... \$50.00

Dear Mr. Underwood,

Due to the occurrence that happened on Sept. 30, 2003 around 5:45 PM, the rendering trailer appeared that the 5<sup>th</sup> wheel had been locked. While making a left hand turn the trailer came off the truck causing excessive blood to leak out of the trailer. Since blood was leaking from the trailer clean up began immediately. Within minutes the police and fire department with the Chief Eddie Brown were here to direct traffic. Mike Merritt from WWT also assisted Dallas Crown, Inc. in advising on what needed to be done as far as clean up. ASC Enviromental was called to clean the blood out of the ditches. Gene Busby was called in to take a percentage of the contaminated dirt and have hauled off to a permitted land fill. Gene also dammed the ditch so the horse blood couldn't run past our property boundaries. Clean up with the help of ASC and the Fire Department and the Maintenance Department continued until 9:30 PM. The clean up resumed again around 9:00 AM on Oct. 1, 2003 with ASC and the Kaufman County Fire Department and the Maintenance Department washing the side of the road and hauling off the contaminated dirt. New dirt was hauled in to replace the dirt that was hauled off.

This was totally an accident. To prevent this from ever happening again, before the trailer is ever moved the driver will be responsible for checking to make sure the 5<sup>th</sup> wheel is locked and also the trailer pen.


